

# SchoolCare TEACHER BRIEFING

**When a student is injured at school, the classroom teacher is often the first person the parent speaks with. We encourage you to refer the parent to the SchoolCare Accident Helpline.**

Thinking about a claim after a child has been accidentally injured can be an anxious time for parents. And for a classroom teacher, it is only natural to reassure the injured student's parent. But it is important that a parent understand the cover provided under the **SchoolCare** Accident insurance.

Catholic Church Insurances **SchoolCare** Accident insurance does not cover the cost of all medical procedures for accidental injuries, including where a Medicare benefit is payable or where there is an out of pocket 'gap' in the Medicare benefit. Other claims may be specifically limited or excluded under the **SchoolCare** Accident insurance.\*
